## Important information

- Each entrant team must comprise a child aged between 5 and 10 years, or 11 and 15 years, and an adult.
- A fee of \$1 per entry (class) is payable on delivery of entries. Entrants will receive complimentary tickets to attend the afternoon tea.
- Entries must be delivered to the Macclesfield Institute, 33 Venables Street, Macclesfield, between 9am and midday on the day of the event (Saturday, May 4). Late delivery may result in the entry being excluded from judging.
- Each entry must be accompanied by a label or card with the name of the recipe and a list of key ingredients. Labels *must not* identify the name of the entrants.
- Judging will commence at midday. Entrants and members of the public are invited to attend the judging session. (Please note, that depending on the number of entries, some classes may be judged 'behind the scenes' to help ensure judging is completed in a timely manner.)
- Agricultural show judging rules will generally apply (see tip sheet for guidance).
- Afternoon tea will be served at approximately 2.30pm.
